## Palm Sunday

28<sup>th</sup> March

10.30am The Liturgy of Palm Sunday  
*The Passion Gospel and the Celebration of the Eucharist followed by an act of witness in University Square*

## Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday

29<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> March

12noon The Litany of Reconciliation and Holy Communion  
7.30pm Compline by Candlelight *with meditations by Canon Adrian*

## Maundy Thursday

1<sup>st</sup> April

10.30am The Chrism Eucharist  
*An opportunity for the renewal of ministerial vows and witness the blessing of the oil used all year for services of baptism and healing.*

7.30pm The Liturgy of Maundy Thursday  
*Canon Adrian leads our recollection of the night before Jesus' death, including a moving feet washing ceremony and a vigil until midnight*

## Good Friday

2<sup>nd</sup> April

9.00am The Liturgy of Good Friday  
*A short, reflective service to mark the most solemn day of the Christian year when we remember the death of Jesus. Followed by coffee and hot cross buns.*

12noon The Litany of Reconciliation

2pm The Stations of the Cross

6pm *Johann Sebastian Bach's Saint Matthew Passion*  
*Saint Michael's Singers perform Bach's masterpiece: the story of Jesus suffering and death; semi-staged and accompanied by the English Symphony Orchestra*

## Easter Day

4<sup>th</sup> April

5.30am The Easter Liturgy, Confirmation and Dawn Eucharist  
*The Easter Fire is lit in the Ruins, before we solemnly process to the new Cathedral for the Liturgy of Confirmation and the Eucharist*

10.30am Festal Eucharist of Easter Day  
*The Cathedral community celebrates Easter with music from the Cathedral's choirs & organ*

4pm Festal Choral Evensong *A choral celebration of the Resurrection*

6.30pm Easter Praise *Contemporary worship for Easter*
