ICONS AMBASSADORS

DO YOU THINK THAT YOUR PUPILS COULD BECOME ICONS AMBASSADORS? If so we offer an education scheme and training days at the cathedral to equip your students with peacemaking skills for the classroom.

ICONs Ambassadors is a leadership programme for children and young people which will develop their understanding of the following:

- Coventry Cathedral's story and the lasting, global legacy of peace and reconciliation that has grown out of it
- The 3 themes of ICONS: 1) Healing the wounds of history, 2) Living with difference and celebrating diversity, 3) Building a culture of peace
- Theory behind ideas of prejudice, conflict transformation, forgiveness and reconciliation and how to apply their understanding to schools contexts
- Skills and values of peace-makers and reconcilers and how to plan for change within the school context

The ICONS Ambassadors Programme is most suitable for pupils in Y4-Y6 and involves attendance of sessions run at Coventry Cathedral.

Each ICON School can send 6 pupils

ICONS CHAMPIONS

WE ALSO OFFER ICONS CHAMPIONS TRAINING TO STAFF TO EQUIP YOU WITH The classroom skills that further reconciliation centred Learning and peaceful practice in the classroom.

What is an ICONS Champion?

An ICON Champion is someone on the staff who is passionate about the concept of ICON Schools and understands the story of Coventry Cathedral and the Cross of Nails as a symbol of peace and reconciliation. This person will drive forward peace-building and reconciliation initiatives and encourage children and staff to engage with the school's work in this area.

This training is for staff in ICON Schools who are intending to take a lead on embedding their ICONS status so that there is ownership across the school community.

Smaller ICON schools may wish to send only one member of staff but larger primaries and secondary ICONS are encouraged to send more than one member of staff, especially if they want to spread impact across several key stages or different departments.

Over time, many members of staff from the same school may attend the training each time it is run to foster the greatest level of ownership.
