

## **ICONS AMBASSADORS**

# COULD YOUR PUPILS BECOME PEACE AMBASSADORS?

ICONs Ambassadors is a leadership programme for children and young people which will develop their understanding of the following:

Theory behind ideas of prejudice, conflict transformation, forgiveness and reconciliation and how to apply their understanding to schools contexts

Skills and values of peace-makers and reconcilers and how to plan for change within the school context

Coventry Cathedral's story and the lasting, global legacy of peace and reconciliation that has grown out of it

The 3 themes of ICONS: 1) Healing the wounds of history, 2) Living with difference and celebrating diversity, 3) Building a culture of justice and peace

The Primary programme is most suitable for pupils in Y4-Y6 and involves sessions run at Coventry Cathedral or by arrangement for schools further afield. Each ICON School can send up to 15 pupils. (£20 per student)

For our Secondary School programme, we are offering onsite training this June (see calendar on page 6). Additionally we are now looking at booking in our sessions for the next academic year but want to make sure that our dates work for YOUR calendars so please fill out this form to indicate when would be best for your pupils - CLICK HERE FOR FORM

# **ICONS CHAMPIONS**

WE ALSO OFFER ICONS CHAMPIONS TRAINING TO STAFF TO EQUIP YOU WITH THE CLASSROOM SKILLS THAT FURTHER RECONCILIATION CENTRED LEARNING AND PEACEFUL PRACTICE IN THE CLASSROOM.

What is an ICONS Champion?

An ICONS Champion is a member of staff who is passionate about the concept of ICON Schools and understands the story of Coventry Cathedral and the Cross of Nails as a symbol of peace and reconciliation. This person will drive forward peace-building and reconciliation initiatives and encourage children and staff to engage with the school's work in this area.

This training is for staff in ICON Schools who are intending to take a lead on embedding their ICONS status so that there is ownership across the school community.

Smaller ICON schools may wish to send only one member of staff but larger primaries and secondary ICONS are encouraged to send more than one member of staff, especially if they want to spread impact across several key stages or different departments.

Over time, many members of staff from the same school may attend the training each time it is run to foster the greatest level of ownership.
